



TeachArtsOhio: Fully Funded Bi-Okoto Cultural Arts Residencies

African drumming, dance, storytelling, and cultural arts through the Ohio Arts Council's TeachArtsOhio Grant — at no cost to schools.

What Is TeachArtsOhio?

TeachArtsOhio (TAO) is an Ohio Arts Council grant that places professional teaching artists in schools for curriculum-connected arts learning. The grant covers 100% of artist fees.

Residency Options

- Mini (2–4 weeks): High-energy introduction to African arts.
- Grading Period (6–9 weeks): Skill-building, standards-based projects.
- Semester (18 weeks): School-wide cultural initiative with culminating performance.

All residencies supplement—not replace—existing arts instruction, as required by the Ohio Arts Council.

What the Grant Covers

- 100% teaching artist fees
- Planning and classroom instruction
- Curriculum-aligned cultural lessons
- Culminating performance or showcase

No cost to the school.
